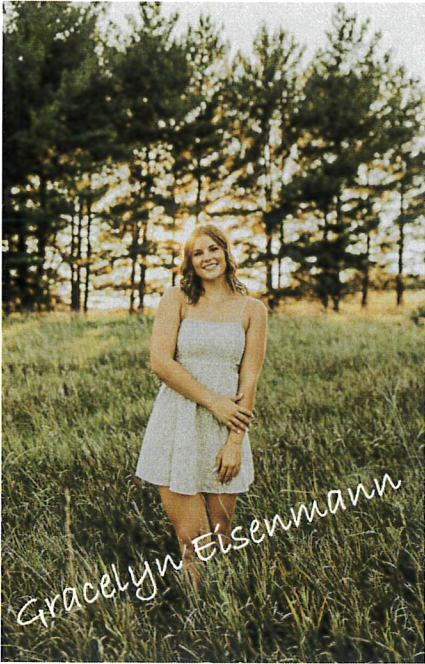
Moved by Urban J, seconded by Hoffman to adjourn at 7:09 p.m. All present voting "aye". Motion carried.
